

Add-ons for Pale Moon and Firefox

Many add-ons for Firefox are for Firefox versions before Quantum. Hence some of the suggestions are no more valid unless you have an older Firefox.

[*Alternative to status bar*](#) in Pale Moon – this is an extension for an older Firefox. Now instead search [*flash_control-2.1.4-fx.xpi*](#) with FIREFOX (!) and *download* the *xpi* file to then install it in Pale Moon from the download. It does not install directly from the website in Pale Moon.

Flashblock does not work with Javascript disabled or with *NoScript* installed.

Pale Moon since May 2018 blocks *NoScript* and wants to uninstall it... claiming that it would be [unstable](#) (maybe because of the *Flashblock* issue, see above). It can, however, be kept if under Preferences > Security the security level is lowered to medium.

NoScript can reasonably be replaced with [uMatrix](#), but then version 0.9.3.6 or 1.0 and not higher in Pale Moon.

[Tab-Mix-Plus](#) is a popular Firefox [add-on](#) that gives users great capabilities for customizing tabs. However, [TMP is bit heavy on the resources and slows down your Firefox browser](#). Also, it has got lot of geeky features and advance settings which requires technical knowledge. So, *TMP* isn't the right choice for an average user. Moreover, *Tab-Mix-Plus* may stop working with other add-ons and may not be compatible with the latest version of Firefox. It is incompatible with *Last Tab Close Button*, but it may instead include its function.

Video Download Helper seems to not work at all with newer versions of Pale Moon, not even version [version 4.9.24.1-signed](#).
